1 TOEICの概要

TOEIC は Test of English for International Communication の略称で,国際コミュニケーション英語能力テストのことである。英語によるコミュニケーション能力を正確に測定するための共通尺度 = モノサシとして定期的に実施されているテストシステムである。TOEIC は英語によるコミュニケーション能力のレベルを正確に知りたいすべての人が利用できる信頼性の高いテストだ。TOEIC はテスト開発に携わる機関として世界最大の規模とノウハウを持つアメリカの ETS (Educational Testing Service) が開発した。これまでに世界の約 50 カ国で実施され,1998 年の受験者数は約 140 万人に上る。日本国内では昨年 1 年間の受験者数は 80 万人を超え,これまでの累計では 600 万人以上に及ぶ。また個人での受験のほか 2,500 以上の企業・団体・学校で採用され活用されている。1996 年より TOEIC の管理団体は ETS の子会社である Chauncey Group International に移っている。また日本における TOEIC の実施・運営には(財)国際ビジネスコミュニケーション協会 TOEIC 運営委員会があたっている。

2 TOEIC の特長

2.1 世界共通の国際コミュニケーション英語能力テスト

TOEIC は , 世界約 50 カ国で実施されている , きわめて信頼性の高い世界共通の国際コミュニケーション英語能力テストである . 日本語を介さず英語だけで行われる他に類のない英語能力テストである .

2.2 個人の能力レベルに合わせた目標点が設定可能

受験級のような区分はなく,受験者全員が同じ試験問題に解答する.結果は合否ではなく,10 点から 990 点までのスコアで出てくるので,初級英語学習者から高度に英語を使える人まで,幅広い受験者が同じ試験問題で,英語によるコミュニケーション能力を測ることができる.従って,各受験者が自分の目標点(合格点)を自由に設定することができ,目安と励みにつながる.

2.3 英語によるコミュニケーション能力が公平に評価される

その国独自の文化的背景や言い方を知らなければ解答できないような問題は排除されている.従って,英語によるコミュニケーション能力だけが,国籍・人種などとは無関係に,公平に評価される.

2.4 英語によるコミュニケーション能力が総合的に評価可能

スピーキング能力とリスニング能力,ライティング能力とリーディング能力には密接な関係がある.TOEIC はリスニング能力とリ-ディング能力を測定するだけでスピーキング能力やライティング能力までもが総合的に評価できるように設計されている.

2.5 毎回のテストによって評価基準が変動することがない

TOEIC では , 評価基準を一定にするために統計・分析による equating (スコアの同 一化)という処理が行われている.従って , 英語能力に変化がないかぎり何回受験しても得点に変動がないよう標準化されたスケール上のスコアで評価が与えられる.これにより時系列的な能力進捗の測定が可能となっている.

3 TOEIC 定期公開テスト

TOEIC は年 7 回 (1 月 , 3 月 , 5 月 , 7 月 , 9 月 , 10 月 , 11 月) 全国 51 都市で実施されている (3 月 , 7 月 , 10 月 , 11 月は受験地限定 .) TOEIC 公開テストは個人での受験のほか , 企業・団体・学校等向の団体申込によるご利用方法 もあり , IP テストと呼ばれる . 我が三木研究室では後者の方法を利用している .

4 テストの概要

TOEIC は 2 時間 (120 分間) で Section I の Listening 100 問と Section II の Reading100 問の合計 200 問に答える 一斉客観テストである。

出題形式は毎回同じで,解答はすべて問題用紙とは別の解答用紙にマークシート(正しいと思われる解答番号を選択して黒く塗りつぶす)方式で記入する.

- 4.1 Section I の Listening テスト (100 問, 45 分間)
 - 4 つの Part で構成され, テープから流れる会話やナレーションを聞いて設問に答える形式のテストである.
- 4.2 Section II の Reading テスト (100 問, 75 分間)
 - 3つの Part で構成されていて,印刷されている問題を選んで設問に答える形式のテストである.
- 5 PROFICIENCY SCALE (TOEIC スコアとコミュニケーション能力との相関表)

6 テスト結果

- TOEIC では,テスト結果を合格・不合格で判定することはせず,スコアで英語能力を評価する.
- Listening スコアは最高点 495 点から最低点 5 点の間の配点.
- Reading スコアも同様に 495 点から 5 点の配点.
- Total スコアは Listening スコアと Reading スコアの合計で,最高点 990 点から最低点 10 点の間で表示される. スコアは 5 点単位で表示されている.

7 問題の構成

- 7.1 Section I Listening (45 分間) 100 問)
- 7.1.1 Part I 写真描写問題 (One Picture) 20 問

問題用紙にある写真を見ながら,テープから流れる 4 つのセンテンスを聴き取り,写真を最も適切に表現しているセンテンスをひとつだけ選択する.

傾向 写真描写は大きく3つに分けられる.

- 情景(景色): 静止物の位置や配置の描写が主である.
- 動作(行動): 人物や動物の動きが中心に描写される.
- 混合問題:情景と動作の混合だが,静止物と人物や動物がどう関わっているかという点が聞かれる.

対策

- キーワードを探せ
- 観察力をつける。
- 作者の意図を研究する
- 聞き方のコツを知る.

7.1.2 Part II 応答問題 (Question-Response) - 30 問

テープから流れる質問とそれに続く3つの応答を聴いて,正しい応答をひとつだけ選択する.

7.1.3 Part III 会話問題 (Short Conversations)-30 問

テープから流れる 2 人による短い会話を聴き,問題用紙にある設問を読んで,4 つの選択肢から正しい答をひとつだけ選択する.

傾向 2人の会話が進められる形.どこでの話(場面)なのか(会話中の単語や語句から把握),どういう関係の人なのか(上司/部下,同僚,友人,先生/生徒,親子,夫婦など),何についての話なのか,を聞き取ることが大切である.また質問と選択肢からも話題を推測するように練習しよう.

対策

- 会話文から内容を把握する(傾向の研究)
- 場面に合った関連単語を知る
- 質問文から会話文を読む

7.1.4 Part IV 説明文問題 (Short Talks)-20 問

テープから流れる短いスピーチまたはアナウンスを聴き , 問題用紙にある設問を読んで , 4 つの選択肢から正しい答をひとつだけ選択する . ひとつの Short Talk に対して設問は 2 つまたは 3 つあり , その各々に解答する .

傾向 基本的には PART 3 に似ているが,会話体ではなく文章も少し長い.年代・曜日・時間・数字・人名・場所などはよく聞かれるが,問題の中心となっているのは何かをあらかじめ設問と選択肢で予測して聞こう.

対策

- スピードに慣れる
- 必要な情報を的確につかむ
- 質問文からリスニングポイントを絞る
- 事実に注意:必要な無い情報も入っている.

- 7.2 Section II Reading (75 分間) 100 問
- 7.2.1 Part V 文法・語彙問題 (Incomplete Sentences)-40 問

短いセンテンスにある空欄に入るものとして最もよく当てはまるものを,4つの選択肢から1つだけ選択する.

7.2.2 Part VI 誤文訂正問題 (Error Recognition)-20問

4 カ所の語または語句に下線が引かれているセンテンスがあり, 4 つの下線部の中から文法上の誤りのあるものを選択する.

傾向

- 文法的な知識を尋ねる問題(知っておかねばならない文法知識と同時に品詞の識別(特に動詞,名詞,形容詞, 副詞など)もよく出題される)
- 類語/イディオムの知識を尋ねる問題(基本的なものが多岐にわたる)

対策

- TOEIC における基本的な文法項目攻略
- 特に大切な品詞群(名詞/動詞/形容詞/副詞)の整理
- 基本的な単語(類語)力やイディオム力をつける.
- 7.2.3 Part VII 読解問題 (Reading Comprehension)-40問

いろいろな資料が提示される、資料ごとにいくつかの設問があり、それぞれに最も適当な答えを選ぶ、

傾向 案内文,広告,料金表,統計,グラフ,メモ,ビジネスレターなど実用的な様々なものが教材となる.読解問題はリーディングセクションのなかの1項目.

対策

- 頭読みを身に付ける.
- スキミング(走り読み:ポイントを絞り,ざっと全体を読む方法)
- スキャニング(探し読み)
- 8 全体としての TOEIC の対策

8.1 語彙

語彙は多い方が良い.しかし知らない語でもそれに引っかかってはいけない.知らない単語が出て来た場合,それにひっかかって,それがあたかも重要であるかのように感じられるが,大抵の場合は,それは重要ではない事の方が多い.

語彙が増えるとイディオムであるかそうでないかについて,直観が働くようになるので,単語はできるだけ知っている方がよい.語源を知っていると結構強い.ラテン語,ギリシャ語,ドイツ語を知れば,大体の単語は把握する事ができる.これらを把握すると言う事は,一般に接頭語,接尾語と呼ばれているものがどういう意味を持つのかを知る事ができ,組み合わせで生成されている単語と言うものが理解できるので,指数関数的に語彙が増えることになる.

8.2 心構え

問題は,間違っても,一つの問題に引っかからない方が良い.リスニングの問題は引っかかってしまうと,それ以上の事ができないような心理状況になる.分からない問題は分からないので,すぐに次に興味を移せるようにする.

8.3 集中力

試験は,二時間あるので,精神的に余裕が無いと難しい.健康状態によっても結構点数は左右される.できるだけ受験する前日には十分な睡眠をとり,余裕をもって挑むことが望ましい.














Fig. 11 問題 10
